“Part One”

I. Three changes are taking place in America.

- A. Everything is moving **faster**.
- B. Every **decision** is getting complicated.
- C. Every **value** is being challenged.

“When people go through rapid times of change they need ‘Islands of Stability.’” (Alvin Toffler)

II. Three things that won’t change.

- A. God’s **love** never changes.

“I, the Lord, do not change.” Malachi 3:6

- 1. Why does God never change?
- 2. It’s because He’s **perfect**.

“I have loved you with an everlasting love.” Jeremiah 31:3

“Preserve my life, O Lord according to your love.” Psalm 119:159

“Nothing living or dead, angelic or demonic, today or tomorrow, thinkable or unthinkable -- absolutely nothing can get between us and God’s love.” Romans 8:38

- B. God’s **word** will never change.

“The grass withers and the flowers fade, but the Word of our God shall stand forever.” Isaiah 40:8

“Long ago I learned from Your statues that You established them to last forever.” Psalm 119:152

- 1. Do you know what the most basic fundamental temptation is?
- 2. The temptation to **doubt** God’s **Word**.

“Everyone who hears these words of Mine and puts them into practice, is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.” Matthew 5:24

C. God's **purpose** for my life will never change.

"God is not a man. He doesn't change His mind." 1 Samuel 15:29

There are at least two reasons why our plans often change.

1. One, you can't see the **future**.
2. You don't always have the **means** to pull them off.

Three very important questions.

1. Can I **miss** God's purpose for my life?
2. Can I get **back** on track after wasting years of my life?

"His plans endure forever." Psalm 33:11

- a. You might have been out of his **will**, but you are never out of his **reach!**

3. What about all those dumb things I've done?

"We know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him and who have been called according to His purpose." Romans 8:28
